2016 \$1.00 QUALIFIER RULES & ENTRY FORM

MEADOWOOD LANES

SATURDAY DECEMBER 3rd & SUNDAY DECEMBER 4th

- Qualify 10/31 through 11/20 during league play. Requires \$1 (per attempt) and a strike in the second frame of the second game. Bowlers may make unlimited attempts to qualify during the qualifying period.
- Tournament is open to all adult RCUSBC members.
- You may bowl only once.
- Tournament will consist of three games:
 - Game #1 **NINE PIN NO TAP** (any 9 count on your first ball each frame counts as a strike)
 - Game #2 **3,6,9 GAME** (automatically given strikes in third, sixth and ninth frames)
 - Game #3 **REGULAR GAME**
- Three divisions:
 - 176 and above
 - 151 – 175
 - 150 and below
- Handicap is based on 80% of 220.
- Averages: Average for this tournament will be 2015-2016 high USBC or USBC youth book average, with a minimum of 21 games. If no last years book average then use highest current season average for at least 12 games as of November 16th. If no average established then bowler will bowl scratch. Incorrect reporting of average will lead to disqualification. **Certified Sport Condition Averages will be adjusted per USBC rule 202a.**
- Rules 319a, 319d and 319e will not apply.
- All rules not covered here will be covered by the 2016-2017 USBC Rule Book.
- No food or drink will be allowed in the settee area, but will be allowed at or behind the counter.
- To be eligible for USBC awards, the game 1 score must be actual score bowled (9-pin no tap strikes do not count for awards).
- **\$10 Entry fee** (\$6.00 lineage, \$4.00 prize fund). 100% of the prize money will be paid back, this includes money collected to qualify for the tournament. Payout will be 1 for every 4 entries.
- (All money collected for entry minus the lineage fees will go to the division of entry).
- \$1.00 will be returned to each bowler who strikes in the second frame of the second game. Remaining qualifying dollars will be added to the prize fund based on number of entries in each division.
- Prize pay-out will be completed within 30 days and the awards will be given to the bowler's league secretary for distribution.
- Submit entries prior to 11/27/2016.
- Those wishing to bowl together must submit paid entries together.
- Entry forms will be available at Meadowood, Robbinsdale and Bandit Lanes. Completed entries may be left at Meadowood, Robbinsdale and Bandit Lanes. Make checks payable to RCUSBC.
- Tournament Management has right to accept or reject any entrant. Rule 303 of USBC 2016-2017 Playing Rules.
- Lane reps from the RCUSBC association will be available to collect your dollar and sign you up for qualifying.
