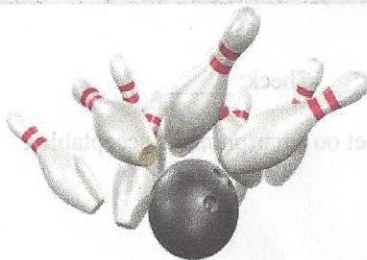

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Game #1: Regular Doubles Game**
- Game #2: Bakers Doubles Game**
- Game #3: Scotch Doubles Game**

Regular Doubles: Each bowler bowls a complete game.
Bakers Doubles: Each bowler will bowl a frame, alternating frames.
Scotch Doubles: Bowler 1 throws the first ball and if any pins remain bowler 2 will have to attempt to pick up the spare. If bowler 1 strikes, then bowler 2 will start the next frame if any pins remain bowler 1 must attempt the spare. The next frame would then start with bowler 1 throwing the first ball and bowler 2 having to pick up any pins remaining.

Tournament Rules:

1. USBC rules and regulations will govern the tournament.
2. All Entrants must be USBC members. Bowlers may qualify for entry by paying associate dues prior to bowling. Eligibility rule 400 will apply to all bowlers.
3. Entries close at the start of the 3:30 shift on Sunday, January 15, 2017.
4. Each bowler will receive 90% handicap of 200.
5. **AVERAGE:** Averages will be accepted in the following order.
 - A. Entrants will use their highest 2015-2016 USBC league average (this includes spring leagues) or current season league average as of tournament date whichever is higher. This includes spring league average.
 - B. If no previous 2015-2016 average, bowler will use current USBC league average as of tournament date provided the bowler has bowled 21 games.
 - C. All others will bowl scratch.
 - D. **BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF AVERAGE!!! Rule 319a-3 regarding verification of average will apply!!!**
 - E. Out of town bowlers must bring verification of average.
6. Rules 319-a-2, 319d and 319e are waived.
7. Format: Tournament will consist of a Regular Doubles Game, Bakers Doubles Game & Scotch Doubles Game.
8. Bowl as often as you like but you can only bowl once with the same partner. Partners will be one Adult and one Youth. The adult bowler must provide an adult USBC card and the youth must provide a youth USBC card. No exceptions. (Multiple Participation Rule 315 will apply).
9. **YOUTH & ADULT Dress Code:** USBC Youth Jersey, Collared Shirt, Mock-Turtle Necks, Slacks, Jeans (clean, with no holes) or Shorts (3 – 3.5 inches above the knee max). Bowlers will be required to change attire if deemed inappropriate by the tournament manager or designee, whose decision is final.
10. Cell phones; pagers, and ANY other form of electronic devices are not to be used by the bowlers DURING the shift they are scheduled to bowl.
11. The divisions will be based on the sum of Averages. Divisions are: 1- 325 & below 2- 326 & above.
12. Trophies will be awarded using a 1:4 ratio.
13. Tournament director shall decide any questions not covered by the rules, however, USBC rules will Apply.
