

PIONEER AWARD: This award honors an individual that has participated in the association for many years and is dedicated to the sport of bowling. This award recognizes participation in bowling and not the bowlers scores.

REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Bowler must be age 65 or older.
- b. The award is based strictly on participation.
- c. Candidates can be nominated by the Awards & Recognition Committee or any member of the local association.
- d. The nomination must be submitted in writing, this includes the nomination form and a signed autobiographical letter from the nominee highlighting their bowling participation as well as any other information that the nominee feels is pertinent.
- e. The Awards & Recognition committee will review all nomination forms and use a rating worksheet to help determine their recommendations to the Board of Directors.
- f. Candidate must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the RCUSBC Board of Directors. The President will only vote in the event of a tie.
- g. Those nominees not selected will have their applications maintained on file and will be reviewed annually for a period of 5 years. A nominee can be resubmitted after that 5 year period.
- h. Award will be presented at the annual awards banquet.
