Adult - Youth Tournament

The Adult/Youth Tournament was held over the past weekend, October 17th & 18th. Fifty Eight sets of doubles bowled the tournament, 32 in the 325 & below division and 26 in the 326 & above.

Highlights of the tournament include - High series for the men, was Nate Hand, entering the tournament with a

237 average, rolled a 789 series. Deidre Ross was the highest scoring woman; entering the tournament with a 176 average she rolled a 612 series. Ty Falcon averaging 196 rolled a 670 series to lead the boys and Shea Hardacre-Stiles rolled a 610 series with a 187 average to lead the girls. Ten year old Drue Hutmacher, averaging 156 rolled his first 600 series, a 655 with games of 228, 194 & 233. There was 1 series over 700 and 20 series in the 600's.

High games rolled during the tournament include Dan Voss, Brady Foreman & Nate Hand leading the men with games of 267. Brandyn Crawford rolled the highest game by a woman, a 235. Ty Falcon led the boys with a 258 and Shea Hardacre-Stiles rolled a 215 to lead the girls. In total there were 67 games rolled over 200.

Most pins over average game included Drue Hutmacher 233 (+77) & 228 (+72), Vincent England 196 (+70), Mitch Sand 222 (+65), Ryan Clarke

254 (+63), Ty Falcon 258 (+62) and four year old - Titan Ross 100 (+58). Most pins over average series included Drue Hutmacher 655 (+187), Titan Ross 237 (+111), Mitch Sand 582 (+111), Titan Ross 224 (+98), and Vincent England 464 (+86).

A lot of good scores and great fun were had by all of the participants. Tournament officials would like to thank everyone that came out to bowl and watch the fun and invite you to participate next year.

The next youth tournament is just 2 weeks away, with the scholarship tournament coming up on November 1st.
