2. All prize money will be returned 100% in cash and awards. An award will be presented to the champion of each tournament. In case of a tie for the championship, co-champions will be declared and duplicate awards will be given.
3. ENTERING AVERAGES: The average used in the RCUSBC Women’s Tournament will be used for this Virtual “600”/”700” Tournament.
4. All rules governing the RCUSBC Open City Championship Tournament will apply to this Virtual Tournament.
5. All USBC rules will apply, unless otherwise stated.
6. Any protest must be submitted in writing to the tournament manager within 72 hours of close of tournament. No unsigned protest will be considered.
